Designed specifically to raise the skill level and confidence of youngsters, the programme encourages you to work towards an industry recognised specialist award as well as having a lot of fun along the way.

You don't have to be an Angus breeder to get involved, as it's for all people aged between 8 and 24 with an interest in cattle. It caters for youngsters of all abilities, those over 14 can achieve a specialist award in Animal Care. This has been matched against the Vocational Qualification National Standards, and has been approved by the National Awarding Body VQSET/PAA.
