PRIZE SCHEDULE & CLASSIFICATION

JUDGE: TO BE CONFIRMED

Rosettes will be awarded to animals standing 1st, 2nd, 3rd in each class and to the Champion and Reserve Champion.

PEDIGREE CLASSIFICATION

SHOW CLASSES will be allocated after inspections.

Any animal female which is 27 months or younger on the day of sale can be shown.

Any animal Bull which is 24 months or younger on the day of sale can be shown.

OLDER CATTLE WILL BE ENTERED FOR SALE ONLY

PLEASE MAKE IT CLEAR ON THE ENTRY FORM IF YOU WISH TO SHOW YOUR ANIMALS OR JUST OFFER FOR SALE ONLY - SHOW CATTLE MUST BE HALTER TRAINED TO LEAD

CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Champion will be awarded with the CHAMPION SASH (in addition to the rosette).

ENTRY FEES

Pedigree Cattle: £30 plus VAT = £36.00 per entry

SOCIETY HERD HEALTH DECLARATION

When applying for entry forms you will be sent a Herd Health Declaration. This MUST be completed and returned with your entry forms.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The show and sale will be held subject to the Auction Rules, Regulations and Bye Laws of The Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society and subject to the Conditions of Sale as recommended by the LAA.
 - 1a. Full copies of the Regulations etc. can be obtained from the Society or Auctioneers.
2. Entry is confined to fully paid up members of the Aberdeen Angus Cattle Society. All cattle **must be** fully registered.
3. The maximum age to be eligible to be shown on the day of the sale of any bull is 24 months or any female is 27 months.
4. Substitutes will not be allowed once the Sale Catalogue has been printed.
5. Any females offered for sale which embryos have been taken must be declared on the entry form and subsequently in the catalogue.
6. Any bulls offered in the sale from which semen has been retained must be declared on the entry form and subsequently in the catalogue.
7. All show cattle must be trained to lead by a halter.
8. **Pre Sale Inspection** All animals entered for the sale will be inspected by a Veterinary Surgeon who will inspect ear tags, teeth and testicles. Any abnormalities found to be serious enough will result in the animal(s) being rejected and the necessity to remove such animals from the sale premises. Any other abnormalities such as warts will also be subject to full veterinary inspection.

Inspections commence SATURDAY, 27th SEPTEMBER – 7.00 a.m.

9. A limited amount of straw will be provided, vendors wishing to have extra straw should bring it with them together with fodder/feedstuffs, buckets etc.

10. All bulls over 10 months old must be nose rung.
11. All pedigree cattle will be sold in guineas with a commission rate of 5%.
12. Inspectors reserve the right to take a blood sample or hair sample.
13. Delivery of stock to the sale premises
FRIDAY, 27th September **3 p.m. – 6 p.m.**
SATURDAY, 28th September **6 a.m. – 7 a.m.**
14. Vendors shall have the right to place a reserve price on any, or all, of their cattle. This must be notified to the Auctioneers in writing, preferably before the commencement of the Sale, and will be treated as a reserve and not a guide.
15. The minimum price for all bulls is 2000gns through the ring.
16. All transactions either by Auction or by Private Treaty following the Sale must be passed through the Auctioneer's Sale Office.
17. T.B. TESTING – PRE-MOVEMENT – As from 1st March 2007 all cattle over 42 days of age from 1 or 2 year testing areas must have passed a TB test within the previous 60 days of the movement. Cattle coming from 3 or 4 year testing areas are exempt.
NOTE: ANY CATTLE ENTERED FROM WALES MUST BE PRE-MOVEMENT TESTED REGARDLESS OF PARISH INTERVAL.
